Man Was Created Free of Sin

Genesis 2:7 — And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Genesis 1:31 — And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good.

Genesis 2:16, 17 — And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat; But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it; for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Man's Sin Cost Him the "Live for Ever"

Genesis 3:11 — Hast thou eaten of the tree . . . I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

Genesis 3:12, 13 — I did eat [man]. I did eat [woman].

Genesis 3:22, 23 — lest he . . . take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden.

Genesis 3:24 — So he drove out the man . . . placed Cherubims, and a flaming sword . . . to keep the way of the tree of life.

Romans 5:12 — by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin . . . death passed upon all men.

Romans 3:23 — For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

Romans 6:23 — For the wages of sin is death.

Man Is of the Earth — Dust, and Is Not a Spirit

- Genesis 2:7 — And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground.
Genesis 3:19 — out of it [ground] was thou taken: for dust thou art.
Genesis 18:27 — I . . . am but dust and ashes.
Psalm 103:14 — For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust.
John 3:31 — he that is of the earth is earthly.
I Corinthians 15:47 — The first man is of the earth, earthy.
I Corinthians 15:48 — As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy.

God's Breath Gives Dust Men Life

- Genesis 2:7 — breath of life.
Genesis 7:22 — All in whose nostrils was the breath of life . . . died.
Job 27:3 — spirit of God in my nostrils.
Job 33:4 — The spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.
Job 34:14 — his spirit, and his breath.
Isaiah 2:22 — man, whose breath is in his nostrils.
Isaiah 42:5 — he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein.
Daniel 5:23 — God in whose hand thy breath is.
Psalm 104:29 — thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.
Ecclesiastes 3:19 — all one breath.
Ezekiel 37:5, 6, 8, 10 — put breath in them.
Acts 17:25 — he giveth life, breath, and all things.
Joshua 10:40 — utterly destroyed all that breathed. (When this happened, those "souls" were destroyed, v. 39.)

Man Returns to Dust at Death

- Genesis 3:19 — dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.
Job 34:15 — man shall turn again unto dust.
Job 40:13 — Hide them in the dust together.
Psalm 104:29 — they die, and return to their dust.
Psalm 146:4 — he returneth to his earth.
Ecclesiastes 3:20 — all are of the dust, and all turn to dust again.
Ecclesiastes 12:7 — Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was.

God's Breath of Life (Spirit) Returns to God When Man returns to Dust

- Ecclesiastes 12:7 — Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit [breath] shall return unto God who gave it.
Genesis 2:7 — And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Job 34:14, 15 — If he set his heart upon man, if he gather unto himself his spirit and his breath; All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust.

Psalms 104:29 — thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.

Psalms 146:4 — His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth.

Death is Called a “SLEEP”

Deuteronomy 31:16 — Moses, behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers.

1 Kings 2:10 — So David slept with his fathers, and was buried.

1 Kings 11:43 — And Solomon slept with his fathers, and was buried.

Job 7:21 — now shall I sleep in the dust.

Job 14:12 — they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.

Psalms 13:3 — lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death.

Daniel 12:2 — And many of them that sleep in the dust.

John 11:11, 14 — Our friend Lazarus sleepeth . . . Lazarus is dead.

Acts 7:60 — And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Acts 13:36 — For David . . . fell on sleep . . . and saw corruption.

1 Corinthians 15:20 — But now is Christ risen from the dead . . . the firstfruits of them that slept.

1 Thessalonians 4:13 — ignorant . . . concerning them which are asleep.

1 Thessalonians 4:14 — them also which sleep in Jesus.

Man is Mortal, That is, Subject to Death

Job 4:17 — Shall mortal man be more just than God?

Job 14:10 — But man dieth, and wasteth away.

Psalms 89:48 — What man is he that liveth, and shall not see death?

John 6:49 — Your fathers did eat manna . . . and are dead.

John 8:52 — Abraham is dead, and the prophets.

Romans 6:12 — Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body.

Hebrews 9:27 — And as it is appointed unto men once to die.

Man Didn't Receive a Living Soul, He Became a Living Soul

Genesis 2:7 — And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.

1 Corinthians 15:45 — And so it is written, the first man Adam was made a living soul.

The Soul is the Real Person, or Life

Genesis 46:26 — All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt . . . were threescore and six.

Exodus 12:19 — that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel.

Numbers 15:27 — And if any soul sin through ignorance.

Acts 2:41 — and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

Acts 2:43 — And fear came upon every soul.

Acts 27:37 — And we were in all in the ship two hundred threescore and sixteen souls.

1 Peter 3:20 — wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

Mark 8:35-37 — For whosoever will save his life [or soul] shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life [same as soul] for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it. For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul [same word as life]? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

The Soul is Mortal and Dies

Joshua 10:35 — and all the souls that were therein he utterly destroyed.

Joshua 11:11 — they smote all the souls that were therein with the edge of the sword, utterly destroying them.

Psalms 22:29 — none can keep alive his own soul.

Psalms 78:50 — he spared not their soul from death.

Psalms 89:48 — shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave?

Psalms 119:175 — Let my soul live, and it shall praise thee.

Ezekiel 18:4 — the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Ezekiel 22:27 — Her princes . . . destroy souls to get dishonest gain.

James 5:20 — he which converteth the sinner . . . shall save a soul from death.

Revelation 16:3 — and every living soul died in the sea.

Christ's Soul Died

Isaiah 53:10 — thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin.

Isaiah 53:12 — he hath poured out his soul unto death.

Matthew 26:38 — My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death.

Mark 10:45 — the Son of man came . . . to give his life [psuche, soul] a ransom for many.

Acts 2:27 — Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell [hades, grave].

Acts 2:31 — the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell.

Romans 5:6 — Christ died for the ungodly.

1 Corinthians 15:3 — Christ died for our sins.

Revelation 1:18 — I was dead.

The Soul Goes Into the Grave at Death

Job 33:22 — Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave.

Psalms 16:10 — For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell [sheol, grave].

Psalms 49:15 — But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave.

Psalms 89:48 — shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave?

Isaiah 38:17 — thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption.

Jeremiah 18:20 — they have digged a pit for my soul.

Acts 2:27 — Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell [hades, grave].

Acts 2:31 — He . . . spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell.

Meanings of "SPIRIT"

General meaning: an invisible force, power, or influence.

1. *Breath of life.*

Genesis 6:17 — I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath [ruach] of life . . . every thing that is in the earth shall die.

Genesis 7:15 — And they went in unto Noah into the ark, two and two of all flesh, wherein is the breath of life.

Genesis 7:22 — All in whose nostrils was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 — Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit [ruach] shall return unto God who gave it.

2. *Wind (weather, atmospheric conditions).*

Genesis 3:8 — And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool [ruach] of the day.

Genesis 8:1 — God made a wind [ruach] to pass over the earth.

1 Kings 18:45 — the heaven was black with clouds and wind [ruach].

Psalms 1:4 — like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

Psalms 55:8 — I would hasten my escape from the windy [ruach] storm and tempest.

Daniel 2:35 — wind carried them away.

Jonah 1:4 — But the LORD sent out a great wind into the sea.

3. *Power or influence from God.*

Genesis 1:2 — the spirit [ruach] of God moved upon the face of the waters.

Matthew 3:16 — he saw the Spirit [Gk., pneuma, same as Heb., ruach] of God descending. (Note: this power from God has been manifested in many ways through the ages.)

4. *A state of mind, or a feeling (called "good" and "evil" spirits).*

Deuteronomy 34:9 — spirit of wisdom.

Numbers 5:14 — spirit of jealousy.

1 Samuel 1:15 — sorrowful spirit.

Job 20:3 — spirit of understanding.

Proverbs 16:18 — haughty spirit.

Isaiah 11:2 — spirit of council and might.

Revelation 18:2 — foul spirit.

5. *Animation, vigor, strength.*

Judges 15:19 — when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived.

1 Samuel 30:12 — when he had eaten, his spirit came again to him.

1 Kings 10:5 — there was no more spirit in her. (Note: the terms, “immortal soul” or “immortal spirit” are not used in the Bible.)

The Spirit of Man

Job 32:8 — But there is a spirit in man.

Job 27:3 — spirit of God in my nostrils.

Job 33:4 — The spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.

Job 34:14, 15 — If he set his heart upon man, if he gather unto himself his spirit and his breath; All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust.

Numbers 16:22 — the God of the spirits of all flesh.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 — Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit [breath of life] shall return unto God who gave it.

James 2:26 — The body without the spirit is dead.

Death is the Result of Sin

Genesis 2:17 — for in the day that thou eatest thereof, thou shalt surely die.

Romans 1:32 — they which commit such things are worthy of death.

Romans 5:12 — by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin.

Romans 5:17 — by one man’s offence death reigned by one.

Romans 6:16 — his servants ye are . . . whether of sin unto death.

Romans 6:23 — the wages of sin is death.

Who has immortality?

1 Timothy 1:17 — Now unto the King eternal, immortal.

1 Timothy 6:15, 16 — Lord of lords; who only hath immortality.

John 5:26 — For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself.

Romans 6:9 — Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.

Revelation 1:18 — I am he that liveth, and was dead; and behold, I am alive for evermore.

The Dead Saints Are Not in Heaven.

Acts 2:34 — For David is not ascended into the heavens.

John 3:13 — And no man hath ascended up to heaven [but Christ].

John 7:33, 34 — and where I am thither ye cannot come.

John 13:33 — as I said unto the Jews, Whither I go, ye cannot come; so now I say to you.

1 Timothy 6:16 — the light which no man can approach unto.
Proverbs 11:31 — the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth.
Matthew 5:5 — the meek . . . shall inherit the earth.
Hebrews 11:39, 40 — And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

There Will Be a Resurrection of All the Dead

Psalms 22:29 — all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him.
Isaiah 26:19 — the earth shall cast out the dead.
Isaiah 26:21 — earth also shall disclose her blood . . . no more cover her slain.
Jeremiah 31:16 — they shall come again from the land of the enemy.
Hosea 13:14 — I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death.
John 5:28, 29 — all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, and shall come forth.
Acts 24:15 — there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.
Acts 26:8 — Why . . . thought a thing incredible with you, that God should raise the dead?
1 Corinthians 15:22 — in Adam all die . . . in Christ shall all be made alive.
2 Corinthians 5:10 — For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things . . . whether it be good or bad.
Revelation 20:4, 5 — they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years, But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished.

The Saints Shall Receive Immortality When Christ Comes, at the First Resurrection

Revelation 20:6 — Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power.
Job 14:14 — If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.
Psalms 17:15 — As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness.
Mark 10:30 — in the world to come eternal life.
Luke 18:30 — in the world to come life everlasting.
Luke 20:35, 36 — But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead . . . Neither can they die any more.
John 6:40 — may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.
Romans 2:7 — To them who . . . seek for glory and honor and immortality, [God will render] eternal life.
Romans 8:11 — he that raised up Christ . . . shall . . . quicken your mortal bodies.
1 Corinthians 15:42 — So also is the resurrection of the dead.

- 1 Corinthians 15:43 — It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory . . . raised in power.
- 1 Corinthians 15:44 — raised a spiritual body.
- 1 Corinthians 15:49 — And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 — the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 1 Corinthians 15:53 — this mortal must put on immortality.
- 1 Corinthians 15:54 — So when . . . this mortal shall have put on immortality.
- Philippians 3:20, 21 — Christ . . . shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body.
- Hebrews 11:35 — others were tortured . . . that they might obtain a better resurrection.
- 1 John 3:2 — when he shall appear, we shall be like him.

The Rest of the Dead Shall Be Raised in the Last Resurrection, After the Thousand Years.

- Revelation 20:5 — But, the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished.
- Daniel 12:2 — And many . . . shall awake . . . some to shame and everlasting contempt.
- John 5:28, 29 — all that are in the graves . . . shall come forth . . . they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

- Romans 2:5, 6 — God . . . will render to every man according to his deeds.
- Romans 6:23 — For the wages of sin is death.
- Galatians 6:7 — whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- Galatians 6:8 — he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption.
- 2 Peter 2:9 — to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished.

Eternal Life is Conditional. The Wicked Will Not Live For Ever.

John 3:16 — that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have . . . life.

Proverbs 15:10 — he that hateth reproof shall die.

Proverbs 19:16 — he that despiseth his [God's] ways shall die.

Ezekiel 18:23 — Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die?

Matthew 19:16 — Master, what . . . shall I do, that I may have eternal life?

Matthew 19:17 — if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

John 3:36 — he that believeth not the Son shall not see life.

John 6:50 — This is the bread . . . that a man may eat . . . and not die.

John 6:51 — if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever.

John 6:53 — Except ye eat the flesh of the Son . . . and drink his blood ye have no life in you.

Psalm 37:28 — the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.
Psalm 37:34 — when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it.
Psalm 37:38 — the end of the wicked shall be cut off.
Psalm 104:35 — let the wicked be no more.
Proverbs 2:22 — But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it.

The Wicked Shall Perish

Job 20:7 — Yet he shall perish for ever like his own dung.
Psalm 1:6 — the way of the ungodly shall perish.
Psalm 37:20 — But the wicked shall perish.
Psalm 73:27 — they that are far from thee shall perish.
Proverbs 19:9 — A false witness . . . and he that speaketh lies shall perish.

Malachi 4:1 — the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven . . . shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Malachi 4:3 — they shall be ashes under . . . your feet.

Matthew 3:12 — He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Matthew 13:41, 42 — they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend . . . and shall cast them into a furnace of fire.

John 15:6 — as a branch . . . cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

Hebrews 10:27 — fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation.

2 Peter 3:7 — reserved unto fire against the day of . . . perdition of ungodly men.

The Grave Hell

Sheol, Old Testament, Hebrew word for **the place of the dead**, is translated grave 31 times, hell 31 times, and pit 3 times.

1. Both righteous and wicked go to sheol at death.

Psalms 16:10 — For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell [sheol].

Psalms 89:48 — What man is he that liveth, and shall not see death? shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave [sheol]?

2. Job, a righteous man, wanted to be hidden in sheol until God's wrath is past.

Job 14:13 — O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave [sheol] . . . until thy wrath be past.

3. Jacob, a man who will be in God's Kingdom, said he was going down into sheol mourning for his son.

Genesis 37:35 — I will go down into the grave [sheol] unto my son mourning.

4. Hzekiah, shortly after God answered his prayer, said that he was going to the gates of sheol.
Isaiah 38:10 — I said in the cutting off of my days, I shall go to the gates of the grave [sheol]: I am deprived of the residue of my years.
5. Sheol consumes sinners.
Job 24:19 — Drought and heat consume the snow waters: so doth the grave [sheol] those which have sinned.
6. Death and sheol (place of the dead) are linked together.
Psalm 6:5 — For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave (place of the dead) who shall give thee thanks?
7. Sheol, the place of the dead, will not last forever.
Psalm 49:15 — But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave.
8. There will be an end of sheol.
Hosea 13:14 — O grave, [sheol] I will be thy destruction.
(Note: Sheol is the Old Testament word translated "hell." Hell in the Old Testament means **the place of the dead.**)

Hades, New Testament, is the Greek equivalent of sheol, and is translated grave 1 time, and hell 10 times. It has the same meaning as sheol, **the place of the dead.**

- Matthew 11:23 — And thou, Capernaum . . . shall be brought down to hell [hades].
 Matthew 16:18 — I will build my church; and the gates of hell [place of the dead, the grave] shall not prevail against it.
 Luke 16:23 — And in hell [hades] he lift up his eyes, being in torments.
 Acts 2:27 — thou wilt not leave my soul in hell.
 Acts 2:31 — resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell [hades].
 1 Corinthians 15:55 — O grave, where is thy victory? [hades, also]
 Revelation 1:18 — have the keys of hell [grave] and of death.
 Revelation 6:8 — his name . . . was Death, and Hell [hades, grave] followed with him.
 Revelation 20:13 — death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them; and they were judged. (Note: Their judgment after coming out of hell [the grave].)
 Revelation 20:14 — death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. (Note: One hell to be cast into the other. Hades to be cast into Gehenna. Hell into hellfire.)

The Lake of Fire Hell — Future

Gehenna, New Testament, Greek word for hell, hell fire, used 12 times, spoken of also as lake of fire, **is to be used of God to destroy the wicked after their judgment.**

Matthew 5:22 — shall be in danger of hell fire.

Matthew 5:29, 30 — not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Matthew 10:28 — destroy both soul and body in hell.
 Matthew 23:15 — ye make him twofold more the child of hell [hell-fire] than yourselves.
 Matthew 23:33 — how can ye escape the damnation of hell? [Gehenna, hell-fire].
 Mark 9:43 — having two hands to go into hell.
 Mark 9:45 — having two feet to be cast into hell.
 Mark 9:47 — having two eyes to be cast into hell fire. (See also, Isaiah 66:24).
 Luke 12:5 — after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell.
 James 3:6 — Tongue . . . is set on fire of hell. (Note: The Lake of Fire is called the **second death**, Revelation 20:14; 21:8). (Note: On fire, see also Psalm 21:9; 37:20; Malachi 4:1-3; Matthew 3:12; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10; 2 Peter 3:7, 10-12.)

Acts 16:15 — she was baptized, and her household.
Acts 16:33 — he . . . was baptized, and he and all his.
Acts 18:8 — And Crispus . . . all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing
believed, and were baptized.
Acts 9:18 — he [Paul] was baptized.
Matthew 3:16 — And Jesus . . . was baptized.
Romans 6:3 — were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?
Romans 6:4 — buried with him by baptism into death . . . walk in newness of life.
1 Corinthians 12:13 — For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body.
Galatians 3:27 — For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put

2 Peter 1:10 — make your calling and election sure . . . do these things.

Galatians 5:22, 23 — But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance.

Matthew 22:37, 39 — love the Lord thy God with all thy heart . . . love thy neighbour as thyself.
